Ron Joseph grew up in central Maine, learning life lessons on his grandparent's dairy farm, and then spent more than thirty years working as a wildlife biologist. *Bald Eagles, Bear Cubs, and Hermit Bill* is a compilation of forty stories that range from his youth to his working life to profiles of the people he has met along the way. Joseph learned to drive a hay truck before turning ten, was once rescued by a hermit, spent time in remote lumber camps along the Canadian border, and helped return eagles to the skies above Maine.
